Through the efforts of **Sarah Weil '05**, **Justin Fielkow '05** and especially **Melissa Tyler Wells '98**, this was a huge success. Alumni were omnipresent at the school's career day. Thanks to the **class of '62** we replaced our banner, which was a Katrina casualty. Unfortunately, the level of support from alums has dropped. Dues and memberships are down. Because of this, we were forced to cut back on our gift to the school and to deny some requests to defray club and band travel expenses. Please, pay your dues.

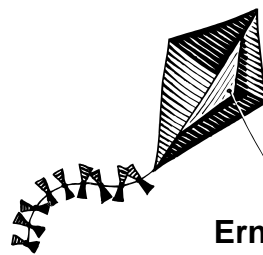
